

Feature Request: Extend the Existing Context Menu to Active Navigation (iOS)

Hello Kurviger Team,

first of all, thank you for developing such an excellent routing application. I use Kurviger Tourer (iOS 3.6.5) extensively for motorcycle touring as well as for scenic drives by car.

During longer tours it is quite common to discover an interesting road, scenic viewpoint, mountain pass, restaurant or hotel that I would like to either include in my current route or simply save for future tours.

At the moment I have noticed the following behaviour:

- While active navigation is running, a long press on the map has no effect.
- After stopping navigation, a long press correctly opens the context menu.
- In route planning mode, this context menu already allows users to:
 - Add a Shaping Point
 - Add a Via Point
 - Save the selected location as a Favorite, without necessarily adding it to the current route.

Therefore, I would like to suggest extending this existing context menu to active navigation rather than introducing a completely new feature.

A long press during navigation could simply open the same context menu with the existing options:

- Add Shaping Point
- Add Via Point
- Save as Favorite

This would offer two important use cases:

1. Modify the current route by inserting a Shaping Point or Via Point.
2. Save an interesting location as a Favorite without changing the current route. Very often I simply want to remember a nice restaurant, hotel, café, scenic viewpoint or another point of interest that I have just passed for use in a future tour.

Since all of these functions already exist in route planning mode, making them available during active navigation would provide a consistent user experience while

requiring only an extension of existing functionality.

A very similar workflow was already available on the former BMW Navigator V and BMW Navigator VI (Garmin). Many experienced motorcycle riders appreciated the ability to save locations or modify their route while navigation was active. Bringing this convenience to Kurviger would be a significant enhancement, especially for touring riders.

In my opinion, this would make Kurviger even more attractive for users of Apple CarPlay, Android Auto and dedicated motorcycle displays, where spontaneous route modifications and saving newly discovered places are very common.

Thank you very much for considering this suggestion and for your excellent work. I would be delighted to see this feature in a future release.
